



SIXNEW **LNG Dual Fuel PCTC Expanding Fleet with Six New Pure Car and Truck Carrier: Order Confirmation** In a significant move signaling our commitment to sustainable maritime operations, we are thrilled to announce the addition of 6 Pure Car and Truck Carrier (PCTC) vessels to our fleet. The order was officially placed on June 15, 2023, with the highly reputed China Merchants (JINGLING) Shipyard. The new fleet expansion includes a mix of four firm orders and two optional, lifting the total number of vessels ordered to date to 8. Each vessel boasts impressive dimensions, featuring a 7,400 Car Equivalent Unit (CEU) Pure Car and Truck Carrier (PCTC) design. Measuring 199.9m in length, 37.70m in width, and a draught of 10.20m, the vessels incorporate a groundbreaking dual-fuel LNG design developed by Deltamarin.
